AGE GROUP(S) & CATEGORIES

All athletes shall be 50 years of age or over as of August 21, 2019 (born on or before August 21, 1969)

32 Archers - 16 female & 16 male

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY & AFFILIATION

All athletes must be a valid member of the Alberta Archers Association upon registration for Alberta Masters Games. Check out: www.archeryalberta.ca/archery-alberta-archery-canada-membership-fees for more information.

Proof of membership will be required at the Masters Games, and photo identification required for proof of age. The Alberta Masters Games are open to residents of Alberta.

EVENTS

Female & Male (Compound & Recurve)

Athletes provide their own equipment & arrows (equipment as per Archery Canada rules)

Friday August 23 – Double 750 (144 shots per athlete)

Saturday August 24 – Elimination & Medal Rounds (approximately 60 shots per athlete)

PROTEST PROCEDURES

Competition protests will follow Archery Canada rules and procedures. Athletes have 30 minutes after the last arrow shot to complete a Protest form and submit it to the Head Judge and Committee.
