

Archery Alberta ASA Tour (AAASAT) Club Requirements

The hosting Club will:

1. Use only Archery Alberta ASA targets for the courses. These targets may only be used on the courses and for the Shoot-Down. For any other activities involving targets, the club must use its own targets.
2. Charge the shooting fees as set out by Archery Alberta.
3. Provide someone to be the club head course director who will work with the AAASAT Director to run the shoot. Example: check that the stakes and courses are ready to shoot.
4. Provide a range officer for each course throughout the day while archers are shooting.
5. Provide people to manage the registration.
6. Provide ASA scorecards for participants. The form can be found on the Archery Alberta website under the ASA Tour Section under downloads
7. Provide tabulation of scores and send that to the AAASAT Director after shooting.
8. Market that the shoot will be part of the Archery Alberta ASA Tour.
